



## **Requirements:**

- Submit the King & Queen Application/Grade Release Form by NOON on September 11th electronically to [election@unm.edu](mailto:election@unm.edu).
- A Candidate must be an undergraduate main campus student in good standing as defined by the ASUNM Constitution and agree to follow all ASUNM Elections Rules & Regulations (See Attached).
- Email a digital photo (At least 1MB - Head Shot Best - NO Instagram/Facebook Photos, they are too blurry) to [lobosprt@unm.edu](mailto:lobosprt@unm.edu) by Midnight, Wednesday September 11th.
- Attend a mandatory meeting Wednesday, September 11th at 5:00pm for all candidates in Fiesta A&B, third floor of the SUB. **If you cannot attend, you must send a representative to take your place. If you arrive after the start of the meeting or fail to attend (or to send a representative), it will result in disqualification. DO NOT BE LATE.**
- Must attend all events on the royalty schedule which will be distributed at the mandatory meeting.
- Do your best to attend any Homecoming events that will be announced (virtually or in-person depending on the event)

## **Coronation:**

Date: Saturday, September 21st at 6:30pm  
If a court member shows any signs of the use of alcohol or drugs, inappropriate dress or behavior before the ceremony or anything deemed a detriment to the position, the candidate will be disqualified immediately by the Student Activities Center representative and not allowed to participate in the coronation ceremony.

## **Qualifications:**

Candidates interested in competing for the honor of Homecoming court must have the following qualifications:

- Undergraduate Main Campus Student carrying at least six (6) credit hours
- Not on any type of University probation
- At least a 2.5 cumulative grade point average. The only exception for not having a 2.5 cumulative GPA is if the student does not have a GPA due to newly entering the University.

## **Deadline:**

- Application/Grade Release form is due to ASUNM (email to: [election@unm.edu](mailto:election@unm.edu)) by **NOON on Wednesday, September 11th, 2024.**
- Campaign rules and regulations and royalty schedule will be discussed at the Mandatory Meeting Wednesday, Sept. 11th, 2024 at 5:00pm in Fiesta A&B, third floor of the SUB.
- The Homecoming King and Queen will be elected by popular vote by the undergraduate student body at the main campus of the University of New Mexico on September 18th via online ballot on [my.unm.edu](http://my.unm.edu).

Please read Article IX in the Election Code carefully for the detailed campaign regulations. Each Senatorial candidate has a spending limit of \$250.00, Vice Presidential Candidates have a spending limit of \$350, and Presidential Candidates have a spending limit of \$400.

## **Article III: Homecoming Election**

### **Section 1. Collaboration**

The Homecoming Election is a joint effort of Lobo Spirit and the Elections Commission.

### **Section 2. Campaign Expenditures**

Lobo Spirit 13

Refer to the Election Code, Article IX, Sections 2, 3 and 4 for campaign regulations related to posting, expenditures, and fines. Campaign expenditures shall not exceed that of candidates for Senate. Financial statements are due no later than 5:00 p.m. on the day of the election.

### **Section 3. Homecoming Elections Commission**

Lobo Spirit will serve in place of the Elections Commission wherever the Elections Commission is named in the Election Code, Article IX, Sections 2, 3, and 4.

### **Section 4. Sanctions**

Sanctions for violating this code are outlined in the Elections Code, Article XIV, Section 1. The ruling of Lobo Spirit may not be appealed.

### **Section 5. Restrictions**

A member of Lobo Spirit, the Elections Commission, or an Election Official may not be a candidate for Homecoming Court.

### **Section 6. Eligibility**

A candidate must be in good standing as defined by the ASUNM Constitution to be eligible to run for King or Queen.

### **Section 7. Election Operations**

Lobo Spirit will establish the election location, date, and operating hours.

### **Section 8. Deadlines and Advertisements**

Lobo Spirit will establish all election application deadlines and advertising schedule.
